### Boat Operator Accredited Training (B.O.A.T) Program

Location: Regina Beach Yacht Club, Upper Deck Lounge

Date and time: July 13 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM

Cost: Course fee (including exam) \$25.00

Books: \$15 each (1 book per family will be sufficient)

Lunch: Please bring lunch. This will allow a shorter lunch break.

Lakes End Boat Operators Certification Services

This is a Canadian Coast Guard approved training program. The requirement for the certification is as follows:

Those born in 1983 or later and operating any motorized recreational boats must carry a Pleasure Craft Operator card. By 2002 this requirement extends to all operators of motorized recreational boats under 4 metres in length. (this includes all personal water craft). By 2009 the regulation affects anyone driving a powered boat of any length.

The certification is a lifetime award and is offered to those 8 years of age and over.

The registration deadline is July 10. To register call the RBYC at 729-2461.
